In order to maximize your summer experience and to ensure that this program is right for you, we request that you please review and familiarize yourself with the guidelines below:

1) Davening Attire: Davening is at 8:45am. In order to ensure proper kavod and decorum for davening, all campers are expected to daven with a hat and jacket. Only regular length pants and button down shirts can be worn during davening.

2) This is a learning camp. A most important and integral part of our day is our Shiurim. Seder is from 9:45 – 12:00 every day. It encompasses shiurim on Halacha, Gemara and Chumash. Every camper is expected to be committed to serious learning during the summer camp session and to attend all learning sessions.

3) No phones or electronic devices allowed. In order to keep our program focused and exciting, we do not allow campers to bring cell phones to camp. Phones are often a distraction that inhibits the ruach of camp. Any phone that is brought to camp, will be taken away and returned at the end of the day. If it is brought a second time, it will be returned at the end of the camp season. Phones are available in the main building for the boys to use. (When going on overnight trips, non-internet enabled phones may be brought along.)
